TERMS OF REFERENCE

RENTAL OF TWO (2) HANDHELD GEOGRAPHIC POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS) FOR THE SURVEY AND MAPPING DIVISION, DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES, REGION V, LEGAZPI CITY.

The Survey and Mapping Division, Technical Services, formerly Land Management Service of DENR V was mandated under DENR Administrative Order No. 2010-18, to formulate policies and develop system for the effective management of land records and information, the objective is to improve the services of the office into a uniform system pertaining to cadastral map, approved land survey plan, public land application and titles.

As per Special Order No. 2020-470 dated November 26 2020 which is "Defining the Internal Organization Set-Up of the DENR which is the Department is the Chairperson of Secretariat to the Inter-Agency Task Force Build Back better and its Organizational Structure which aim to serve as a central body to ensure the whole of government implementation and monitoring of post recoveries and rehabilitation. As a designated Focal Person of one of the Key Result Area (KRAs) on Recovery and Rehabilitation and Reconstruction and in pursuant to the EO No. 120, Series of 2020 the DENR Region 5 created the team to conduct Demarcation and Actual Survey of Rivers and Creeks along Bicol River Basin. The team aims to identify the 20 meters legal easement along the Rivers from the municipality of Bato and end to the municipality of Cabusao. The team will undertake the geo-tagging which covers 204.176 kilometers which starts to Bato, Baao, Nabua, Bula, Minalabac, Milaor, Naga City, Camaligan, Gainza, Pamplona, Canaman, Libmanan, Magarao Bombon, Calabanga and Cabusao. In order to ensure the expected GEO-TAGGING result, the team need to use the GPS to generate data with pictures and provide landmark for the easiest identification of the lot and easement surveyed hence this terms of reference. The GPS is badly needed and intended in the implementation of Demarcation and actual survey since it provides systematic result, precise and desired data for Land Survey which is the primary concern for the Demarcation of legal easement of 204.176 kilometers , 77 affected barangays and approximately 800 affected lots within the Bicol Region.


TERMS AND CONDITION

That the prospective bidder(s) must indicate his/her compliance in the submitted Bid of the following:

1. With One (1) Year Warranty on parts, its accessories and installation. The bidding winner shall ensure the equipment delivered must be free from all forms of defects and craftsmanship;
2. Equipment found to be defective after delivery should be replaced immediately by the winning bidder without any additional obligations from the Procuring Entity;
3. That the contractor shall provide an Authorized Service Center within the Bicol Region for the immediate repair or replacement of defective equipment. Repaired or replaced items shall have their warranty extended three (3) months or until the date when the original warranty period would have expired.
4. That technical support and training for the DENR personnel shall be provided by the winning bidder/company to ensure accurate uses of the surveying instruments, hence it will generate the desired and precise data for land survey and mapping.
5. Schedule of delivery of item shall be for a period of thirty (30) days upon issuance of Notice to Proceed.
